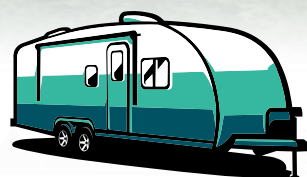

Introduction to the Scientific Programme



The SPIDS week 2026 Scientific Program is Thoughtfully structured into 4 main Categories. These categories include the Scientific Segment, which is arranged into sessions or symposia, Open forum discussions, Research, and educational sessions. Furthermore, for the first time, and in -line with this year's theme of Saudi Arabia 2026 – The Year of AI was introduced. Additionally, the program includes a carefully crafted Professional, career- oriented inspiring and ethically ground presentations. That said, there are few outlier segments or the "Grab Bag" items that don't neatly fit into any single theme. These are often an out - of - the - box, creative sessions, designed to add a splash of fun, surprises and creativity to the overall experience.

1- Scientific Sessions/Symposia:

40 – 90 minutes, including Q & A session

2-4 talks (2-4 speakers)

2 chairpersons

Each session/symposium consists of a focused topics built around a specific domain or track in the field and features a specialised presentations that are delivered by experts Physicians in the track. SPIDS week covers 15 unparalleled sessions in different tracks. Tracks are color-coded in the program to ease navigation.
